

Traveling from the North on I-95: Take exit 32, Turn right at stoplight onto Rt. 111 Continue straight onto Rt. 202 at Alfred (~11.4 miles) Turn right onto Rt. 109/Main St. in Sanford (~3.9 miles) Gym is 1 mile on right. **ENTRY & ADMISSION FEES**

General Rules

1.	All entered models should be at least 75% plastic (no wooden models) – with the exception of figures and 1/43 scale cars. NOTE – Models entered in Scratch-built &
	Conversion Categories (11, 19, 32 & 41) need not meet the 75% plastic requirement.

2. No sweeps – one winning entry per contestant per category (except in open judged categories).

- 3. No previous DowneastCon first place winner, nor any AMPS or IPMS Regional or National winners (1st, 2nd, 3rd) are eligible to be entered in competition.
- 4. Out of Box means just what it says the model is assembled from the contents of the kit box. No altering or modifying of the kit parts unless detailed in the instructions. INSTRUCTION SHEETS MUST BE INCLUDED WITH THE DISPLAY AT THE TIME OF ENTRY Rigging, antennas or decals for seat belts may be added. Aftermarket decals are allowed.
- 5. In the Documented Vehicle category, a photo of the real vehicle **MUST** accompany the model.

6. Collection: 3 to 5 models that will be judged on how closely the models are related to one another. A collection with more than 5 models WILL NOT be judged.

- 7. Each entry must be built by person named on registration form. No absentee registration, the builder must be present.
- 8. DowneastCon SMSM/IPMS Head Judges decision will be final. Judges may eliminate or split categories as needed.
- 9. Models will NOT be handled. A base will be provided to place the model on to assist in turning during judging (except for some larger models).

10. No nude figures per IPMS guidelines

11. All dioramas must fit on the show tables. Please limit your diorama to a maximum 24 x 36 inch base.
