

"M&M—Monsters & Machines" President's Award "People's Choice Award"
"Bud Lindemann Car and Track Award"
"Cats" "Patton Mug"

"Wings of the Mighty Eighth" "Grand Master's"

"Best Of Class Awards"

For each category and Best Of Show plus the David Quick Memorial for Best Young Modeler

- "M&M—Monsters & Machines." Any monster or machine with a monster name; i.e. Dodge Demon, McDonnell F3H Demon, F-4B Phantom II, M18 Hellcat, Terminator machines, etc. (Any scale, era, or genre).
- The President's Award will go the Best Model of club president's choice that deems worthy of a President's Award.
- "Wings of the Mighty Eighth: Harold "Buck" Rigg Memorial Award" is anything related to 8th Air Force from WWII to present from aircraft to missiles.
- "Bud Lindemann Car and Track Award" is for any car manufactured between 1964 to 1979 which covers the beginning of his sportscast in "Autoscope" to his last in "Car and Track".
- "Cats" is a car theme sponsored by Hope Contractors. Any car or truck with either a cat type name or title; i.e., Dodge Hellcat, Jaguar, Nissan Leopard, Mercury Cougar, Chevrolet Cheetah, etc. (all types, all scales).
- "Patton Mug" for any US Army/US made tank regardless of whose markings are on them, all sizes/all eras, except dioramas.
- **People's Choice Award** is sponsored by Bob Hyatt, of Little Rock, AR., and awarded to an entry based on general public's vote.
- Grand Master's Award Any model that has won the "Best of" award at any level whether local, regional National, or other modeling contest venue.



Directions

I-20 from West (Dallas) take Exit 11 towards Alexandria (Inner Loop Exp LA-3132); take the Bert Kouns-Ind Loop/LA-526 exit, EXIT 9; Keep RIGHT to take the Bert Kouns-Ind Loop ramp; Turn LEFT onto E Bert Kouns Industrial Loop/LA-526; Turn RIGHT onto Millicent Way; When you reach the traffic light, LSU-S is straight ahead

I-49 from South Louisiana take the Bert Kouns -Ind Loop exit, EXIT 199, toward LSU SHREVE-PORT; merge onto E Bert Kouns Industrial Loop; Turn RIGHT onto Youree Dr/LA-1; LSU-S is on the LEFT

From the North: Follow I-49 SOUTH; Merge onto I-220 W via EXIT 210B on the left toward Dallas; I-220 W becomes Inner Loop Expressway; take the Bert Kouns-Ind Loop/LA-526 exit, EXIT 9; Keep RIGHT to take the Bert Kouns-Ind Loop ramp; Turn LEFT onto E Bert Kouns Industrial Loop/LA-526; Turn RIGHT onto Millicent Way; When you reach the traffic light, LSU-S is straight ahead

I-20 from East (Monroe) take Exit 19A (US-71 NORTH/LA-1 NORTH/SPRING ST) keep left and merge onto LA-1 South; Stay on LA-1 (Youree Drive) at the next split Go south on LA-1 (Youree Drive) for 8 miles and you will see the University on your left
