National Contest Committee Report on the 2016 National Contest

Columbia, South Carolina August 3-6, 2016

Overview

The 2016 IPMS/USA National Contest was held during the annual convention in Columbia, South Carolina, on August 3-6, 2016. There were 1,967 total contest entries in 201 categories. There were seven additional awards presented for the host chapter's themes, three awards for special interest areas, and twelve awards for the best-in-class and overall show awards.

NCC Judges Seminars

The NCC conducts a 90-minute seminar for anyone interested in participating or learning more about the judging process. OJT (on-the-job training) judges are welcomed to join the judging process. Typically, only one OJT is placed on a judging team, but is encouraged and allowed to participate fully in the decision-making process of the judging team. This year, over 50 individuals attended the "What Judges Look For" seminar, held on Thursday, August 4.

In addition to this seminar, a one-hour judges' meeting was held immediately prior to the start of judging on Friday, August 5. The purpose of this annual session is to reiterate the judging standards and ethics expected of all judges, review the recording process, and introduce the Class Head Judges. 150 judges were in attendance for this annual meeting and participated in judging.

Judging began at approximately 7:00 pm, and concluded with the final Judges' Grand Award decision made by midnight. The recording, photography, and awards presentation efforts continued throughout Friday night and all day Saturday in preparation for the Saturday evening presentation.

The efficiency of the judging process and duration continues to improve each year, thanks to the hard work and efforts of the Class Head Judges and their support teams in preparing their preliminary decisions and placement of models into split categories. This preparation has greatly reduced the time required for the judging process.

NCC Judging Certification

The NCC recognizes seniority in judging by awarding certificates for 3, 10, and 20 years of judging service – a program which was initiated by Aris Pappas in 1990. This seniority is determined by the judges signing into a log book for each year that they participate in judging, including their first OJT (on-the-job trainee) judging year. 


Change in overall number of contest entries from the prior year lowest value in category

Rank refers to the overall size of the contest. For example, Atlanta (2005) is ranked #1 as the largest contest, based on the count of contest entries




In this chart, RED = West Region, BLUE = Central Region, YELLOW = East Region





