Overview

The 2016 IPMS/USA National Contest was held during the annual convention in Omaha, Nebraska, on July 26-29, 2017. There were 2,161 total contest entries in 197 categories, receiving 571 awards for first, second, and third place within each category. There were seven additional awards presented for the host chapter's themes, six awards for special interest areas, and thirteen awards for the best-in-class and overall show awards.

Approximately 150 judges participated in the contest judging, led by the NCC Class Head Judges:

NCC Judges Seminars

The NCC conducted two 60-minute seminars for anyone interested in participating or learning more about the judging process. The first seminar, "What Judges Look For," was held on Thursday morning, July 27, with approximately 45 attendees. This seminar highlighted errors in construction and finishing which might result in an entry not receiving an award; such as misalignment of wings, wheels, unpainted surfaces, etc. The second seminar for "prospective judges" was targeted specifically to new on-the-job trainee (OJT) judges, and reviewed standards and practices of the judging corps.

OJT judges were welcomed and encouraged to join the judging process. Typically, only one OJT is placed on a judging team, but is encouraged and allowed to participate fully in the decision-making process of the judging team. This year, over 70 individuals attended the "Prospective Judges" seminar, held on Friday, July 28.

In addition, a one-hour judges' meeting was held immediately prior to the start of the judging process on Friday, July 28. The purpose of this annual session was to reiterate the judging standards and ethics expected of all judges, to review the recording process, and to introduce the Class Head Judges. 150 judges were in attendance for this annual meeting and participated in judging.

Judging began at approximately 7:00 pm, and concluded with the final Judges' Grand Award decision made by 1:00 am. The recording, photography, and awards presentation efforts continued throughout Friday night and all-day Saturday in preparation for the Saturday evening presentation.

The efficiency of the judging process continues to improve each year, thanks to the hard work and efforts of the Class Head Judges and their support teams in preparing their preliminary decisions on category splits and placement of models into split categories. This preparation has greatly reduced the time required for the judging process.

NCC Judging Certification

The NCC recognized seniority in judging by awarding certificates for 3, 10, and 20 years of judging service – a program which was initiated by Aris Pappas in 1990 (28 years ago). This seniority is determined by having the judges sign into a log book for each year that they participate in judging, including their first OJT (on-the-job trainee) judging year. 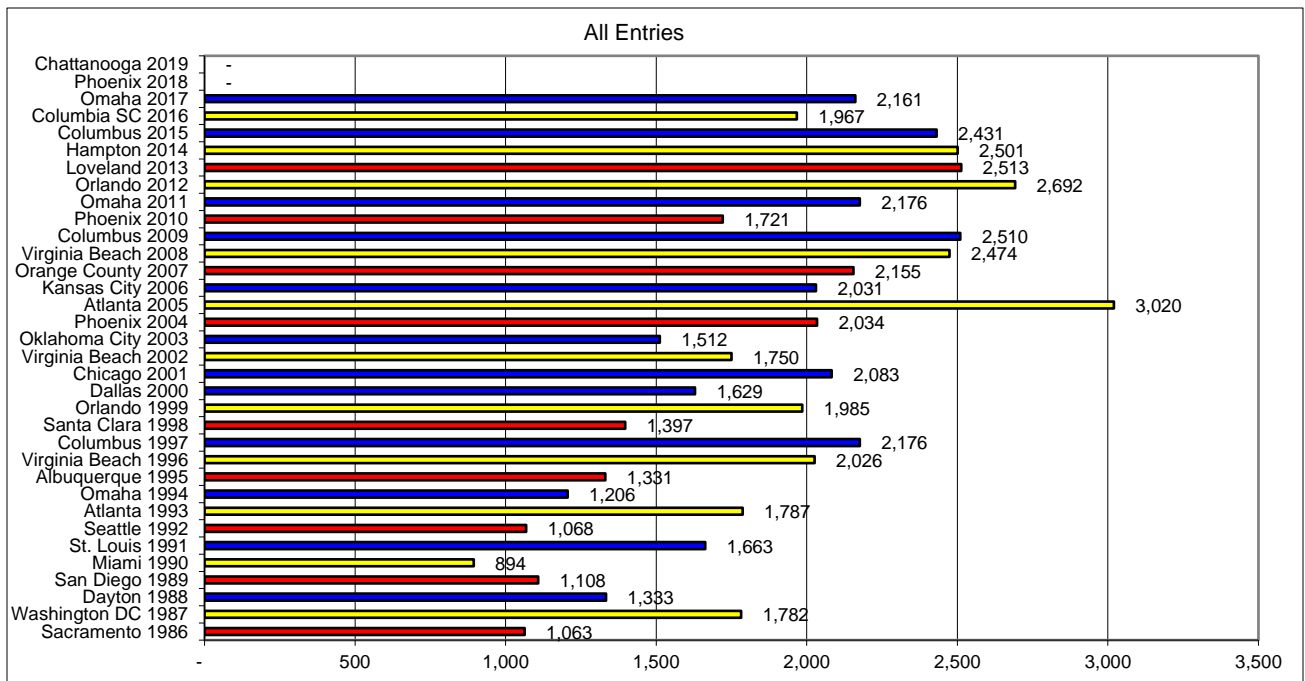

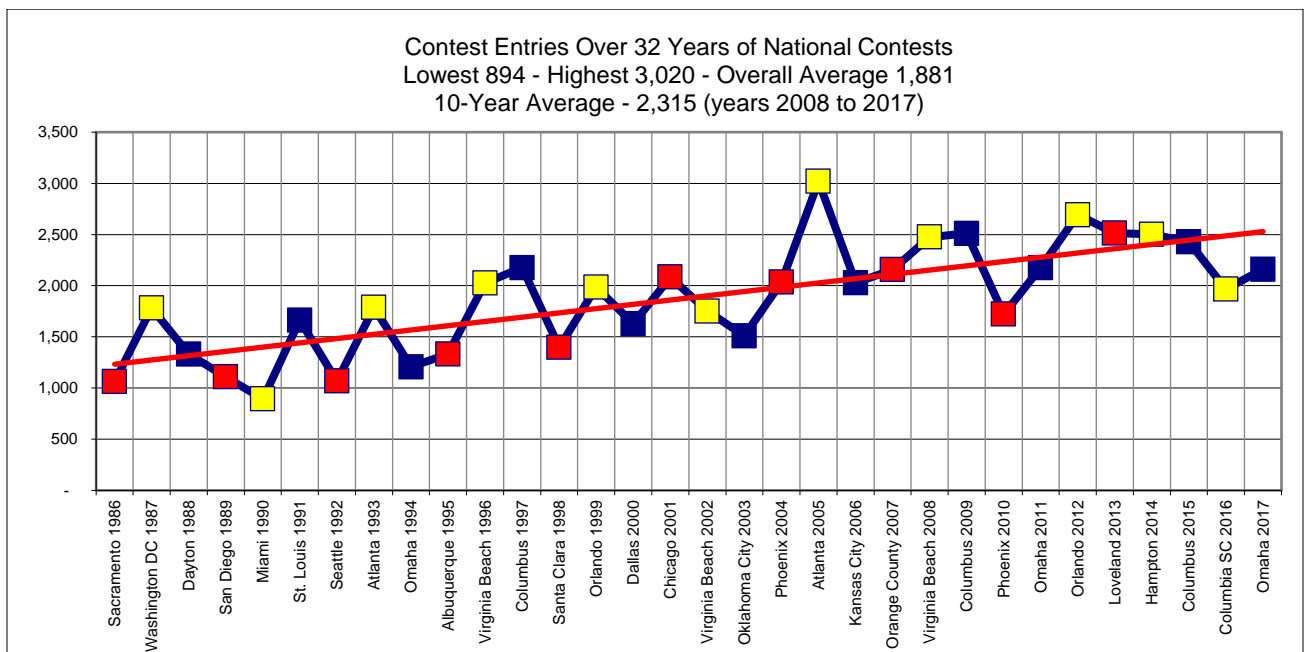

In this chart, RED = West Region, BLUE = Central Region, YELLOW = East Region

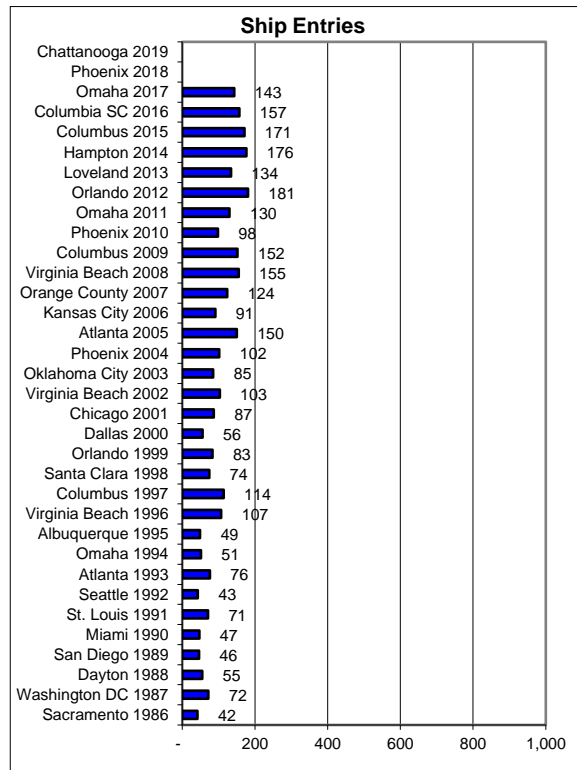
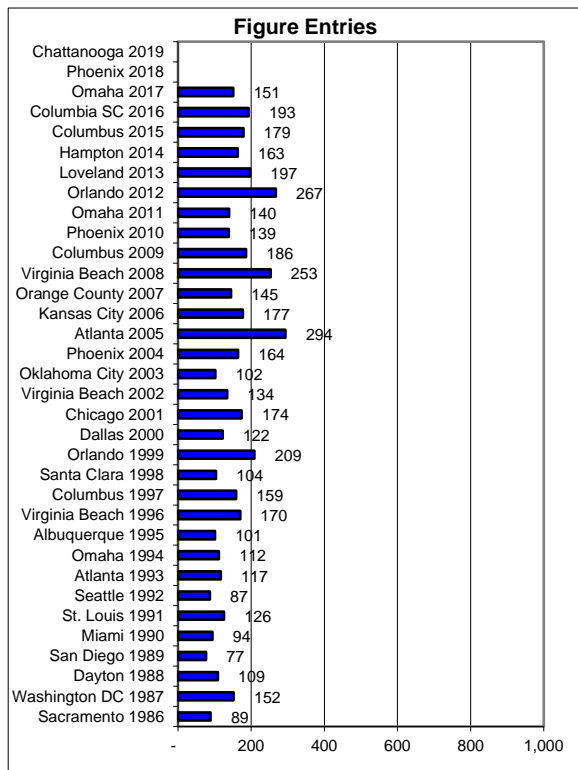
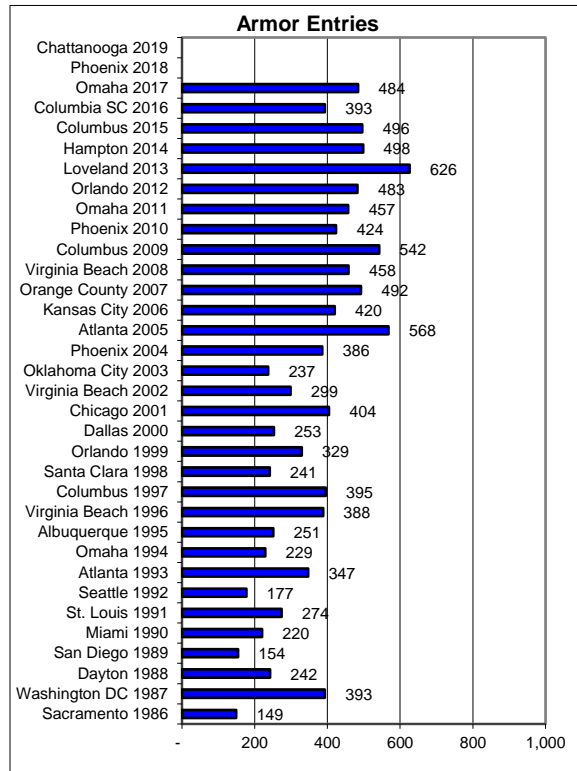
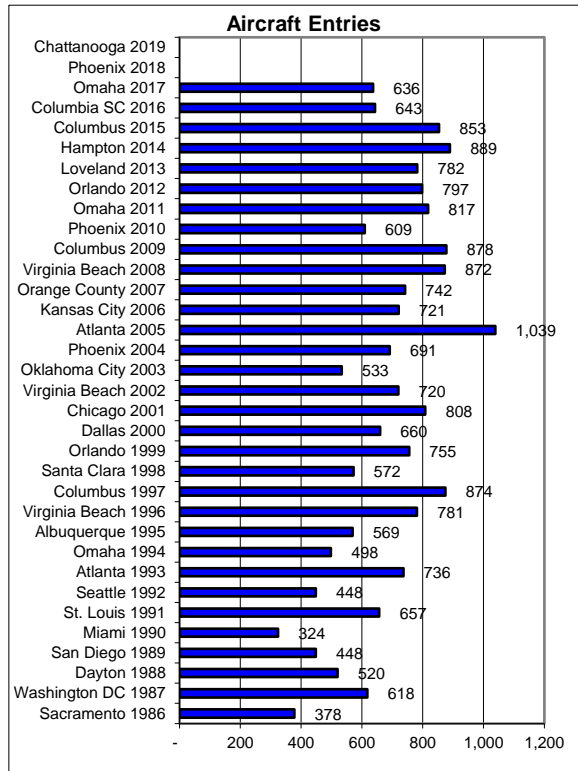


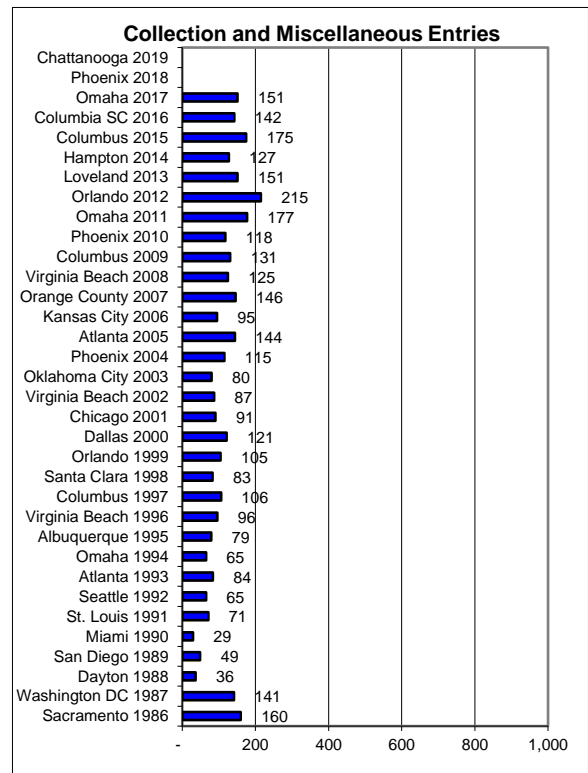
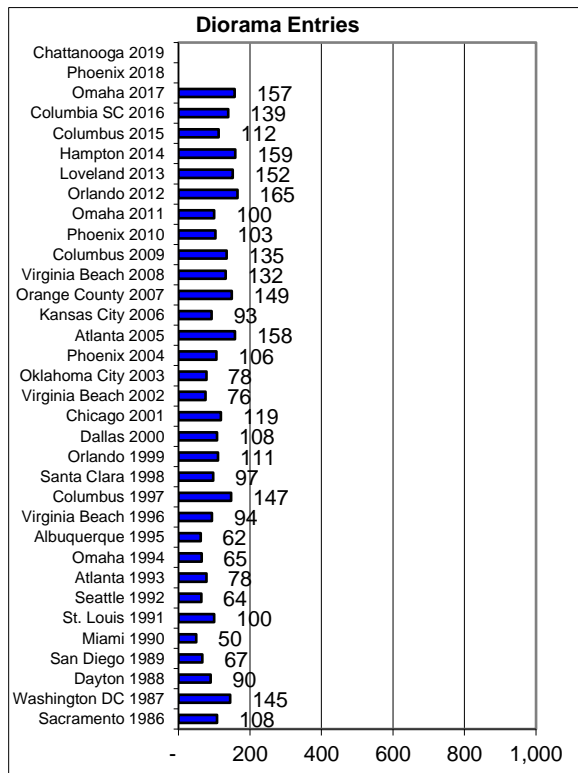
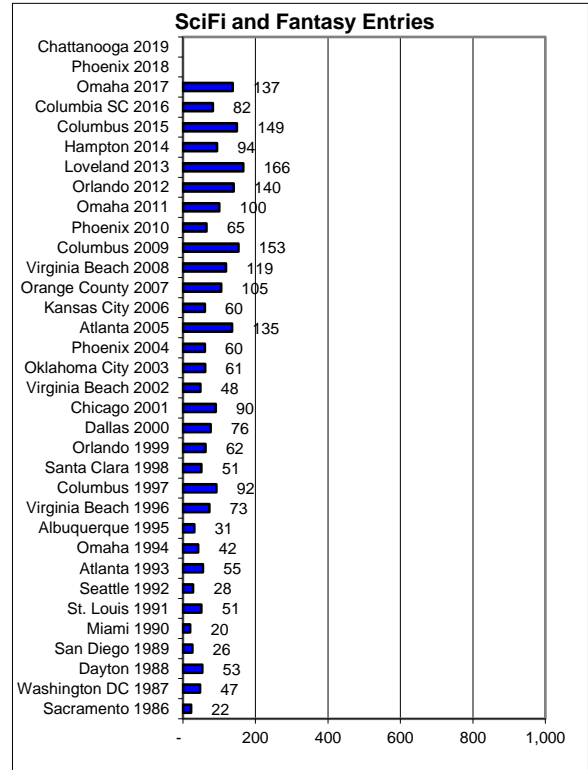
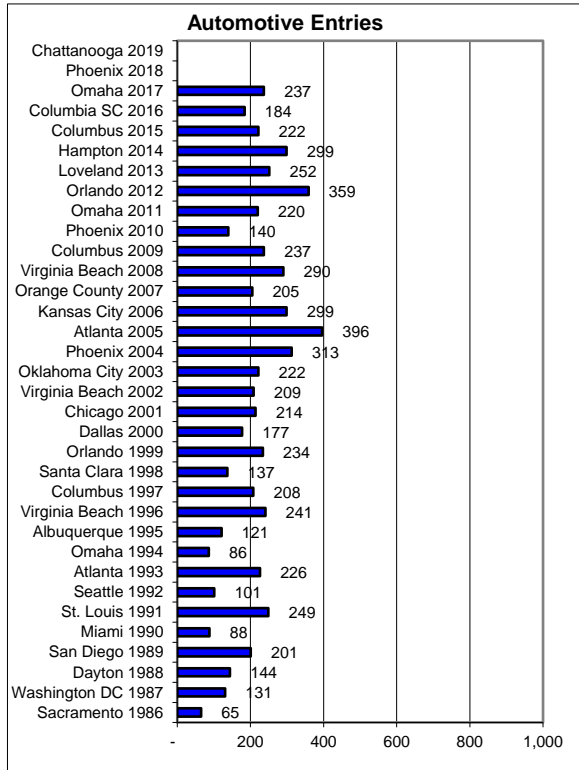

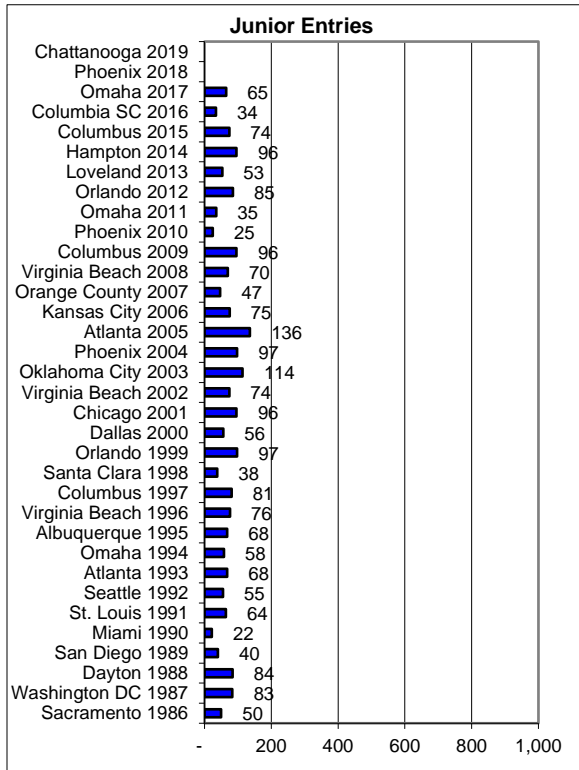
